AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from Sh. Tejpal Singh, SDO, Water Supplies & Sanitation, Punjab, states that the bills with regard to the claim of the petitioner have been submitted to the District Treasury Officer, Bathinda, on 04.10.2016. He further states that the amount shall be released to the petitioner within a period of two months.

This contention of the learned counsel for the respondent is not acceptable. Direction is issued to the District Treasury Officer, Bathinda, to release the amount/benefit qua the petitioner within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the contempt petition in case the directions are not complied with by the District Treasury Officer, Bathinda.

The contempt petition is disposed of with above observations.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged, subject to above.
