Counsel for the petitioner asserts that the order passed by this Court has not been complied with. He contends that the legal notice served by the petitioner, which was to be considered and decided by passing a speaking order, has not yet been decided. In response thereto, counsel for respondent No.2 has referred to Annexure R-2/1, where the copy of the minutes of the meeting of the respondent-Society have been attached, where parawise claim of the petitioner in the legal notice has been considered and replied to. He, further, states that in case the petitioner is aggrieved by

the decision, which has been taken by the Management Committee, he can avail of his remedy in accordance with law.

I have perused the resolution dated 28.01.2015 Annexure R-2/1 and am of the considered view that the said resolution fulfills the requirement as mandated and required by the order dated 26.08.2013 passed by this Court in Civil Writ Petition No.4839 of 2013 (*Sukhjinder Singh Vs. Additional Secretary (Cooperation) and others*). In case the petitioner is aggrieved of the said decision, which has been taken by the Management Committee vide its resolution dated 28.01.2015 (Annexure R-2/1), he may avail of his remedy in accordance with law.

With these observations, the present contempt petition stands disposed of.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
