In compliance with the order passed by this Court in CWP No. 11161 of 2014 titled as Shyam Lal vs. State of Haryana and others, whereby directions were issued to the respondents to verify the claim of the petitioner, as projected by him in his representation dated 16.05.2013, and take an appropriate decision in accordance with law/policy within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. The respondents although have not complied with the order within the time stipulated, however, now a speaking order dated 03.11.2015 has been passed, copy whereof has been appended as Annexure R-1 along with the affidavit dated 06.05.2016 filed by the Land Acquisition Collector, Urban

accepted.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the order, as passed by the Land Acquisition Collector, is against the Policy and, therefore, cannot be sustained as the land is available for release whereas it has been stated in the order passed that it is not so available.

If that be so, the petitioner may avail of his remedy, in accordance with law, against the said order, as has been passed by the Land Acquisition Collector, referred to above.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
