Reply by way of affidavit of Ms. Renu S. Phulia, Director, Women and Child Development Department, Haryana, has been filed in Court, taken on record. In compliance with the order passed by this Court on 17.10.2014, a well-reasoned speaking order dated 29.09.2016 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.

Counsel for the respondent has referred to para 4 of the written statement. As per the said paragraph, the retiral benefits have already been released to the petitioner. With regard to the Leave Travel Concession (LTC) for the block year 2008-12, an amount of Rs.31,768/- was to be paid, which has already been released to him on 04.10.2016. He, on this basis, contends that the orders having been complied with by the respondent renders the present contempt petition infructuous.
