The petitioners' writ was disposed of on 23.9.2015 simply by directing Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 3.6.2015 and take appropriate action as warranted by law. The petitioners thereafter sent a legal notice as well, which has now been decided by the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali vide his order dated 5.12.2015 informing them that SIT has already been constituted under the supervision of the Superintendent of Police (Investigation), Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that so far only 7 petitioners have been called out of 34 though much time has expired but the investigation is not making any headway.

Be that as it may, the grievance raised by the petitioners, at this stage, can only be looked into in case they file a petition under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C.
