dated 22.06.2015 (Annexure R-3), the same have been executed through police help as per the report of Surinder Singh, Kanungo. The report is appended as Annexure R-4. The Gram Panchayat was put in possession of the land measuring 20.5 marlas comprised in Khasra No.35 with the Lal Lakir of village Jhande in the presence of certain persons detailed therein and thereafter, possession handed over to Amanpal Singh, Panchayat Officer, Block Majitha, with the police help, who had been appointed as Administrator of the village Panchayat, Jhande.

In view of the above, counsel for the respondent submits that the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous.

Counsel for the petitioner, with regard to handing over of the possession, states that he has no instructions.

Having considered the reply which has been filed by the respondent, the orders as passed by this Court have been duly complied with rendering the present contempt petition infructuous. Disposed of as such.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged.
