This petition is filed for the alleged disobedience of the order dated 11.11.2013. The operative part of the order reads thus: -

“This petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner will be paid higher pay scale equivalent to the basic salary of the Lecturer for the period for which she had been performing the duties of Lecturer in Computer Science plus usual allowances as per the rules. The said arrears will be paid to her for a period of three years prior to the date of filing of the petition.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has admitted that the arrears have been paid for three years but the petitioner is claiming the higher pay scale which is equivalent to the basic salary of the Lecturer for the period for which she was performing the duties.

Learned counsel for the respondent in this regard has submitted that earlier part of the said order followed by the later part which refers to the arrears to be paid to the petitioner of the higher pay scale equivalent to the basic salary of the Lecturer for the period of three years prior to the date of filing of the petition.

In view thereof, I do not find any merit to interfere in this petition.

Dismissed.
