Separate replies on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2 are filed today in Court and copies thereof are given to counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the order dated 27.07.2015, passed by this Court, direction was issued to the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 21.01.2015 and to take steps/corrective measures within a period of one month.

Admittedly, the corrective measures have not been taken within a period of one month as directed.

In reply, filed by respondent No. 1, it is admitted that food stocks of 23487.35 MT was lying at the site, out of which 11768.25 MT has already been lifted by way of tenders and remaining 11719.10 MT shall be lifted within a period of two months as the tenders have been floated.

For the delay caused, the Deputy Commissioner has tendered

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his apology by way of an affidavit in this regard.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with another direction to the Deputy Commissioner concerned to comply with the order in its *letter and spirit* within a period of next two months i.e. on or before the 14.09.2016.

In case the order is not complied with, the Deputy Commissioner Taran Taran shall remain present in Court.
