Short reply by way of affidavit of C.Sibin, Ex Director, Rural Development and Panchayats, Punjab -respondent no.1 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

The order dated 7.7.2014, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to look into his grievance in the light of letter dated 13.2.2013 (attached as Annexure P-2 to the writ petition) in accordance with law, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and the complaint of the petitioner decided after due enquiry.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order so passed in case he is dis-satisfied with the same. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
