The parties are present in person in Court.

The respondent stated that he is ready and willing to take the petitioner-wife along with him, to which she is not agreed stating that all earlier efforts in that regard failed.

The respondent is working with Life Insurance Corporation of India, Unit-I, Jeevan Deep Building, Sector 17-B, Chandigarh 160017.

The respondent was to pay maintenance to the petitioner @ ₹ 5,000/- per month with effect from 18.12.2012. As claimed by the petitioner, not a single penny has been paid till date.

Considering the aforesaid facts, this Court does not have any other option but to attach the salary of the respondent. The Branch Manager, Life Insurance Corporation of India, Unit-I, Jeevan Deep Building, Sector-17 B, is directed to credit 1/3rd salary of the respondent in the account of the petitioner in Jammu & Kashmir Bank bearing A/c No. 0669040100000493, regularly.

The petition stands disposed of.
