AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the orders passed by this Court have been duly complied with, however, he states that the details with regard to the fixation of the benefits and the calculations of the arrears are not known to the petitioner.

Counsel for the respondents submits that the details thereof will be supplied to the petitioner within a period of four weeks.

On doing so, if the petitioner feels aggrieved, she may make a representation to the Superintendent of Police, Railways, Ambala, within a period of eight weeks from the date she received the information. If such a representation is made within the time stated above, the same shall be considered and decided by the Superintendent of Police, Railways, Ambala, within a period of six weeks from the date of submission of such representation and convey the decision on the claim to the petitioner.

In case the claim is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to the petitioner within a further period of four weeks.

The contempt petition is disposed of in above terms.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
