In compliance with the order passed by this Court on 16.12.2016, the photographs have been produced by counsel for the respondents and on perusal of the said photographs, this Court is satisfied that there is a duly mettaled road which reaches the plot which has been allotted to the petitioner.

It has been alleged that there is certain encroachment on the road, which this Court finds none. Apart from that, as far as the plot of the petitioner is concerned, there is no encroachment at all and it is a clear plot.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition does not survive as the petitioner has been allotted Plot No. 765-E, Sector-57, Gurgaon.

The present contempt petition stands disposed of accordingly.
