The petitioners have filed the present contempt petition alleging non-compliance of the order dated 9.12.2015 passed by this court.

While referring to the observations made in the order, it is stated that this court opined that merely on the basis of impugned letters/orders, entries in the revenue record could not be changed. The impugned letters/orders were set aside. However, liberty was granted to the State to pass order afresh. The submission is that the entries made in the revenue record deserve to be reversed, the moment the order was set aside. However, I do not find this to be a fit case for initiating contempt proceedings. The matter was not finally decided by this court but was remitted back to the authorities for passing a fresh order. The rights of the parties would be determined only after the competent authority passes a fresh order. No case for initiating contempt proceedings is made out.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
