The direction issued by this Court on 01.02.2016 in CRM No. M-1161 of 2016 has been complied with by the respondents as is apparent from the short reply by way of affidavit of Satinder Singh, Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna, District Ludhiana, which is filed in Court, taken on record, copy supplied to the counsel for the petitioner. The speaking order, on the representation of the petitioner, has been passed by the respondents on 10.11.2016 (Annexure R-1).

Counsel for the petitioner states that an incomplete challan has been presented and the original important documents of the petitioner such as Passport, Pan Card and the receipt, on the basis of which, the FIR was lodged, are not attached with the challan, which has been submitted in Court.

Counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Sh. Mohinder

that the departmental proceedings have been initiated against S.I. Darshan Singh bearing No. 275/Khanna, who has been placed under suspension. He further states that the efforts are being made to trace out the said documents.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous. Petitioner may avail of his remedy in accordance with law.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
