Reply by way of affidavit of Jasdeep Singh, PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar (Rural)- respondent no.1 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

The order dated 23.9.2014, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider and decide the representation/complaint (attached as Annexure P-3 with the writ petition) within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order so passed in case he is dis-satisfied with the same. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
