Reply by way of affidavit on behalf of respondents filed in
Court, taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner, on the basis of the said reply
referred to above, submits that the petitioner has not been granted the
benefit of promotion which he is entitled to in the light of the consequential
benefits granted to the petitioner.

Counsel for the respondents, in response to this, has referred to
para 3(ii) on merits of the affidavit to contend that the promotion from the
clerical cadre to the official cadre is by way of a departmental/merit channel
test, in which the petitioner has not participated which was held in the panel
years of 2006, 2007 and 2008. After the reinstatement of the petitioner
with effect from 21.05.2015 till date, no promotion exam from clerical to
official cadre has been held.

In view of the submissions made by the counsel for the parties,
this Court is of the considered view that order passed by this Court has been
substantially complied with by the respondents.

Let a speaking order with regard to the claim of the petitioner for promotion be passed within a period of three weeks and conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

The contempt petition stands disposed of.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
