The order of the writ Court mandated the amount to be paid as interest at the rate of 9 per cent on the amounts deposited by the petitioner from 12.3.1990 till the date of delivery of possession which has since been done as has been stated in para 4 of the reply.

Reply was filed on 24.9.2014. No counter affidavit has been filed to controvert the assertions made in the affidavit.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents in case of any grievance/shortfalls. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
