Considering the reply dated 01.07.2016 filed by the respondent, according to which the name of the petitioner has been forwarded for consideration for selection to the Indian Forest Services as per the applicable rules and thereafter the Review Selection Committee has been held on 23.06.2016 at 10:00 am in the UPSC, New Delhi, for inclusion of the name of the petitioner in the selection list of 2000 to 2004 for appointment in IFS cadre, Haryana. The final outcome of the said Committee being not known, the order passed by this Court dated 26.09.2013 has been substantially complied with which was within the domain of the respondent. The order in the considered opinion of this Court has been complied with by the respondent within their power and jurisdiction. The final outcome of the Review Committee which has been held cannot be ordered to be so declare in a contempt petition, especially when the Union Public Service Commission was not a party to the writ petition or the present contempt petition.

The contempt petition is disposed of with above observations.

Rule issued stands discharged.
