MAHESH GROVER, J.

The order dated 28.5.2013, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider and decide the representation to be made by the petitioner within a period of 6 weeks by passing a speaking order within a period of 2 months from the date of submission of such a representation. It was further mandated that in case of acceptance of petitioner's claim, all consequential benefits be released to him within a further period of one month.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and payments including interest have been made to the petitioner.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to alternate remedies in law in case of any dis-satisfaction. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
