Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that efforts are being made to settle the debts of the State Bank of India and Punjab Financial Corporation. At this stage, he seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one after the debts of the creditors are settled.

Learned counsel for the Official Liquidator pointed out that for publication of notices in the newspapers inviting claims from the creditors/workers, the Official Liquidator has spent amount from the Common Pool Fund Account. He prays that the amount so incurred be got reimbursed from the company in liquidation.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn. As far as the expenses incurred for publication of notices in the newspapers by the Official Liquidator from the Common Pool Fund Account are concerned, as and when the properties of the company in liquidation are sold, he shall be at liberty to get the amount reimbursed therefrom.
