1. The petitioner's grievance is that an injunction which was granted will fetter the defendant from carrying out any repair. The property has been let out to the Bank and it would require immediate attention. Such a contention had been taken in the application for injunction itself but the same has not been considered by the court. Even while maintaining the order, I give the liberty to the defendant to approach the court for such modification giving out the special circumstances that would require modification to be done. If such an application is filed, the grant of injunction already granted will not be come in the way for fresh consideration.

2. The revision petition is disposed of with the above observations and liberty granted to the defendant.
