AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

These are two revisions which are filed against the concurrent orders of the Courts below allowing ejectment of the petitioner-tenant from the demised premises.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Anil Chawla, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of the respondents.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions from his client has stated that the petitioner will not press this petition on merits but some reasonable time should be granted to him to vacate the premises voluntarily without forcing the respondents to press the execution petition.

Learned counsel for the respondents has accepted the plea of reasonable time with the stipulation that the petitioner files an undertaking before the Executing Court within 15 days that he would vacate the premises voluntarily on or before 31.08.2016 and continue to pay the rent in advance by the 7th of every month and also pays other charges regularly and will also pay the up-to-date arrears of rent within one month from today and that in the event of any default this petition would have to be deemed to be dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions has stated that this offer is accepted to him.

Revision petitions stand disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
