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**AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)**

This revision has been filed against the concurrent orders of the Courts below allowing ejectment of the petitioner-tenant from the demised premises.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is a student and will vacate the premises voluntarily on or before 15.05.2016 without forcing the respondents to file an execution petition if reasonable time is granted to him till the end of his examination. He further undertakes to pay the entire rent upto that date and the other admissible charges within a period of 15 days from today.

Learned counsel for the respondents after taking instructions has also accepted this offer on the condition that the petitioner will file an undertaking to the above effect before the Executing Court within 15 days, failing which, this revision should be deemed to be dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has accepted this condition.

In the circumstances, the revision petition is disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
