The present revision petition has been filed against the order dated 18.10.2014, vide which the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Jind has partly allowed the application filed by the petitioner for releasing the amount of the F.D.R releasing only Rs.4 lacs out of Rs.13,31,663/-, which was awarded to him as compensation on account of death of his father in the motor vehicular accident and the aforesaid amount is lying depositing with the Union Bank of India, Mangolpuri, Delhi in Fixed Deposits No. 7405260 dated 29.05.2013.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is major. Annexure P-3 is his birth certificate, which shows his date of birth to be 21.12.1995. In this way, he is more than 20 years of age. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner requires money for

purchasing of house and for further education. The needs projected by the petitioner seems to be genuine.

3. So, the present revision petition is hereby allowed and the Branch Manager of respondent no.4, Union Bank of India, Mangolpuri, Delhi is directed to release whole of the amount of the F.D.R No. 7405260 dated 29.05.2013 along with interest to the petitioner as per rules under proper receipt.
