This petition has been filed against the order dated 8.2.2016 allowing the petition under Section 13-B of the East Punjab Urban Rent Restriction Act, 1949 and thereby evicting the petitioners from the demised premises.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, states that the petitioners will not press this petition on merits and will vacate the premises voluntarily on or before 30.11.2016 without forcing the respondent to file an execution petition provided that the respondent will not take any further rent from the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions, has also accepted this offer on the condition that the petitioners will file an undertaking to the above effect before the Executing Court within 15 days, with the condition that in the event of any default, this petition should be deemed to be dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has accepted this condition.

The revision petition is disposed of in the above terms.
