K.Kannan, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is the owner who is the 2nd respondent. He has a right to give evidence. He shall not, however, bring any new document, but, if the driving licence was already filed by the driver but he withdrew the application, it cannot mean that the copy of driving licence which he produced in Court was also permitted to be taken along with him. If the document is still available, the petitioner shall be given opportunity to give his own application about the driving licence produced before the Court. The withdrawal of application cannot mean permission given to the party to take back the document furnished in court. The order already passed stands clarified that the petitioner can give his own version about his *bonafides* or otherwise with reference to the possession of the driving licence by his driver.

I have dispensed with the notice to the respondent and dispose of the revision with the above directions.
