The present petition has been directed against the order dated 02.01.2015 (Annexure P4) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division) Faridabad whereby application filed by the petitioner for additional evidence has been dismissed.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that by way of additional evidence, he wants to tender into evidence certified copy of affidavit dated 18.05.1992 purported to be executed by Smt. Khazani Devi and others and does not want to examine any witness to prove the document.

Counsel for respondent No. 1 states that they have got no objection if the said document is allowed to be tendered into evidence subject to decision qua its execution and admissibility by the trial Court.

In view of the above, the petitions stands disposed of with a

direction to the trial Court to allow the petitioner to tender into evidence certified copy of affidavit dated 18.05.1992, subject however that the question of execution and admissibility is left open, to be decided by the trial Court.
