By invoking the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the present petition lays challenge to the order dated 13.11.2014 (Annexure P5) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division) Ludhiana whereby the petitioner has been directed to pay the requisite Court fee in view of his claim for damages to the tune of Rs.5,00,000.00, detailed in para 9 of the plaint.

The learned trial Court has taken note of two judgments passed by this Court '*State of Punjab and others v. Jagdip Singh Chowhan*' 2005 (2) Civil Court Cases 37 (P&H) and '*Manjeet Singh v. Beant Sharma*' 2012(4) PLR 287 (P&H) and held against the petitioner that he is liable to pay the requisite Court fee on the amount of Rs.5,00,000.00.

In view of the observations made in *Manjeet Singh's* case (supra), which squarely covers the controversy in question, this Court does not find any error much less illegality in the impugned order as would call for intervention.

For the reasons afore-mentioned, the petition is dismissed in limine. No order as to costs.
