Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the light of the final order passed by the Appellate Authority, Jalandhar, on 22.01.2016, the present revision petition has been rendered infructuous as the order under challenge will not operate qua the petitioner as it was an interim measure and further the appeal having been allowed, the petitioner-tenant will continue in the same terms and conditions on which the tenancy had come into existence and, therefore, the question of arrears of rent would not arise.

Counsel for the respondent would not dispute the statement of the counsel for the petitioner and he states that the present revision petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the parties, especially that of the counsel for the petitioner, the present revision petition is disposed of.
