1. Whether reporters of local newspapers may be allowed to see judgment ?
2. To be referred to reporters or not ?
3. Whether the judgment should be reported in the Digest ?

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**AMIT RAWAL, J. (Oral)**

The petitioner-plaintiff is aggrieved of the impugned order, whereby application seeking amendment of the plaint for incorporating the relief of possession has been declined.

Mr. Gorakh Nath, learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner submits that initially suit for partition and consequential relief of permanent injunction was filed. However, during the pendency of the suit as indicated in the application, the plaintiff was dispossessed and accordingly amendment as noticed above was sought to be incorporated but the same has been declined.

Notice of this revision petition was issued to the respondent.

There is report of refusal on behalf of respondent as indicated in the order dated 04.04.2016. Accordingly, I proceed to decide this revision petition on merits.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and appraised the paper book and of the view that amendment sought to be incorporated is most innocuous being subsequent event. Subsequent event can always be allowed to be impleaded failing which the plaintiff may suffer in seeking execution of the decree in case of succeeding in suit. Defendant would have right to cross-examine the plaintiff witnesses, much less, rebut the written statement qua alleged dispossession.

For the foregoing reasons, impugned order is hereby set aside.

Application seeking amendment of the plaint is allowed.

Resultantly, revision petition stands allowed.
