AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this revision petition the petitioner has challenged the order dated 25.02.2015 closing his evidence.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that apart from the merits, if the petitioner is now granted one last opportunity he will produce his entire evidence and the only assistance he requires would be dasti summons for the witnesses.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Divanshu Jain, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents has argued that the

petitioner has been delaying the trial of the case but if one last opportunity is granted it would be appropriate if the date is fixed by this Court and reasonable costs are paid to the respondents.

In view of the assertions of both the learned counsel, the present revision petition is allowed. The petitioner is granted one last opportunity to produce his entire evidence at his own responsibility and the only assistance that he would seek through Court is issue of dasti summons to the witnesses. Let dasti summons be issued by the Rent Controller to the witnesses for 11.03.2016 subject the payment of Rs.10,000/- as costs.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
