AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed against the order of the Appellate Authority declining amendment in the written statement.

Learned counsel for the applicant has argued that in the original written statement the plea was taken in the reply to para 1 but now in appeal the only amendment which is being sought is that he should be allowed to take it in preliminary objection. Learned Appellate Court has also observed that the motive behind this application is just to delay the matter and would not have any effect on the merits of the case. I fail to understand as to how it makes a difference.
