Petitioner had instituted the instant petition in the year 1991 praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus to command the respondents to adjust him against the post of Fitter-II in the Kaithal Cooperative Sugar Mills Ltd., Kaithal. A Writ of Certiorari was also sought seeking quashing the order dated 5.7.1991 at Annexure P-4, whereby such claim of the petitioner had been declined.

Stand of the respondent-Kaithal Cooperative Sugar Mills Ltd., Kaithal was that the petitioner had never been selected on the post of Fitter-II and rather had been adjusted on the post of Fitter-III on 89 days basis keeping in view the exigency of work.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner had contested such stand and accordingly on the last date of hearing i.e. 27.7.2016 the original proceedings pertaining to selection and appointment to the post of Fitter-II conducted in response to advertisement dated 10.3.1991 had been called for.

The original record has been produced by learned counsel appearing for the contesting respondents. The same has been perused even

by counsel appearing for the petitioner. Counsel for the petitioner makes a statement that the record does show that the petitioner had not been selected on the post of Fitter-II.

In the light of such position, the prayer made in the present petition cannot be accepted and is consequently dismissed.
