Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the divorce petition by mutual consent has already been filed at District Courts Sri Mukatsar Sahib and even the statement of the parties in the first motion has been recorded. He further states that the statement of the parties in the second motion could not be recorded as the respondent-husband took the stand that he will make the statement after the FIR is quashed. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the present revision petition may be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to move the application for revival of the revision petition in case the compromise between the parties is not matured.

Thus, the present revision petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn. The petitioner shall be at liberty to move the application for restoration of the present revision petition if respondent-husband backed out from the compromise.
