Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the decree against which RSA is pending in executing proceedings, proclamation has been drawn, objection against the same has also been dismissed and submits that his client is willing to settle with respondent and undertakes to pay a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- within 15 days and rest of the amount in installments of four months. Subject to deposit of Rs.1,00,000/-, within fifteen days from today, property shall not be put to auction and in case of non-deposit, consequential action seeking execution of the decree shall start.

Revision petition is disposed of, in the aforementioned terms.
