The present petition has been directed against the orders dated 16.03.2015 passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division) Kurukshetra and dated 09.02.2016 passed by the Additional District Judge, Kurukshetra whereby the application filed by the respondents/plaintiffs for interim injunction was allowed and the appeal preferred by the petitioner/defendant against the order of the trial Court, has been dismissed.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as the case is now pending for recording evidence of the defendants including the petitioner, the present petition may be disposed of but the trial Court may be directed to decide the suit in a time bound manner.

In view of the above, the instant petition stands disposed of. As the case is pending for recording evidence of the defendants, it is for the defendants including the petitioner to take necessary step(s) to conclude their evidence at the earliest.
