1. The revision is against the order declining the amendment to the plaint to make reference to the sales effected by the brothers and for impleadment of the alienees. The suit was for a declaration of property left behind by the mother through a Will. The contest is by the brothers of the plaintiff who have denied the Will. The alienees were surely necessary parties to enable the plaintiff to secure appropriate reliefs for declaration and consequential benefits.

2. The order already passed declining such relief is erroneous and it is set aside. The revision petition is allowed. The purchasers are ordered to be impleaded and the plaint is ordered to

be amended. Notices shall be sent by the trial court to the newly impleaded parties, the written statement elicited within the time that it might prescribe and proceed with the trial in accordance with law.
