By this application, the applicant-petitioners seek advancement of the date of hearing in the main petition and wish to withdraw the revision petition in view of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners and respondents. Respondent No. 1-Lachhman Singh is a respondent in the connected regular second appeal also.

The application is allowed. The main case is taken up for hearing today itself.

Learned counsel submits that as a matter of fact the petitioners are not parties in the connected appeals as they were not parties to the suit. However, they had filed this revision petition against the judgment of the learned Courts below, as are impugned in the accompanying appeals, in view of the fact that by the said judgment, the petitioners' rights were affected, even

though they were not party to the lis. He submits that now a compromise has been arrived at between the petitioners and respondents in this revision petition, a photo stat copy of which is annexed with the application as Annexure A-1, alongwith a translated copy thereof.

Consequently, in view of this application, which is accompanied by the affidavit of the first petitioner, who is the mother and natural guardian of petitioners No. 2 and 3, the revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
