Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the present petition may be disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court to dispose of the main petition under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 (for short Act) expeditiously and in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the respondents contended that in-fact the petitioner is delaying the disposal of the petition. He has filed the petition in the year 2009. Even after seven years, he has not concluded his evidence.

So, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court to dispose of the petition filed by the petitioner under Section 25 of the Act expeditiously preferably within a period of six months.
