AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This revision petition has been filed against the concurrent orders of dismissal of eviction petition under Section 13 of the East Punjab Urban Rent Restriction Act, 1949 on the ground of non-payment of rent.

Both the Courts below found that the petitioner had herself accepted in the cross-examination that the rate of rent was Rs.500/- p.m. and that the respondent had paid till October, 2002.

In my opinion, there is no scope for interference. Revision

petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
