AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner states that the case before the Rent Controller, Hisar, is fixed for today. He submits that one opportunity may be granted to the petitioner to produce all his evidence. He very fairly states that three effective opportunities have been granted to the petitioner to produce his evidence but he has failed to do so and on the last occasion when the impugned order was passed, the reason was the ill health of Smt. Savitri Devi, who was not in a position to appear before the Court because of medical reasons.

Although this Court finds no justification for granting another opportunity to the petitioner but keeping in view the interest of justice, one opportunity is granted to the petitioner to lead his entire evidence, which he shall do today itself.

This shall be subject to payment of ₹10,000/- as costs to the respondents-landlords prior to he being given the opportunity to lead his evidence.

The revision petition stands disposed of accordingly.
