Learned counsel appearing for respondent submits that petitioner earlier preferred the petition against the same order dated 1.8.2015 (Annexure P-2). The said petition was dismissed by a Co-ordinate Bench (Ritu Bahri, J.) on 3.12.2015 by passing a detailed order. According to him, petitioner without disclosing this fact again invoked the revisional jurisdiction of this court under Article 227 of the Constitution of India.

In view of above, this petition is dismissed. However, petitioner shall be at liberty to seek revival of the petition in case aforesaid averment is found to be incorrect. In that eventuality, this court shall consider imposition of appropriate costs which shall not be less than ₹ 1.00 lacs.
