Present petition is challenge to the order dated 15.03.2012 passed by Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Div.), Sunam whereby decree holders were directed to return the excess amount, as already quantified vide order dated 15.3.2012 till 17.09.2013 failing which the said amount was ordered to be realized from the surety furnished by decree holders/respondents.

The only contention raised by learned counsel for the petitioner is that despite this order, no action is being taken by decree holders nor by the executing Court i.e. Court of Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Div.), Sunam.

In view of the above, there is no merit in the present revision petition and the same stands dismissed. However, petitioner shall move appropriate application before the Court below to seek remedy available as per law.
