Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that present writ petition was ordered to be heard with CWP No. 5647 of 1981 (Krishan Lal and others Vs. State of Haryana and others), vide admission order dated 30.11.1983 passed by a Division Bench of this Court and the said writ petition has already been decided vide order dated 18.12.2008. They further submits that since the present writ petition is squarely covered by the decision dated 18.12.2008 rendered in **Krishan Lal's case** (supra), it may be disposed of in terms of the order dated 18.12.2008 passed in **Krishan Lal's case** (supra).
