The petitioner's husband died on 5.10.1992, as work charge employee while performing the duty of a driver. The claim is for fixing pension and releasing all pensionary benefits along with consequential relief of arrears.

The case was ordered to be heard along with **Civil Writ Petition No.7072 of 1994-Lakha Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others.**

The said case has been decided today i.e. 6.1.2016 vide separate order on the basis of judgment dated 21.10.2015 of the Full Bench of this Court in **Lakha Singh's case** (supra) wherein it has been held that work charge employee is not entitled to pension since engagement is governed by a different statute.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed.
