The order passed on 09.04.2015 at the stage of execution was for securing a 1/3rd of the amount to be not disbursed by the Punjab State to its Collector. The idea was to protect the share claimed by the petitioners. As regards 2/3rd share, respondent No.3 shall be permitted to withdraw for herself and on behalf of children after taking such security as it is necessary under the Act. As regards 1/3rd share, the same shall be transmitted back to the credit of the case, if the amount has come to this court or retained by the court itself and have it deposited in a fixed deposit account yielding

interest. The final adjudication will determine the entitlement or otherwise of the petitioner to the 1/3rd amount that is being directed to be retained. The civil revision is disposed of.
