1. There is no representation for the respondents.
2. The revision petitioner who is in possession of property has no grievance about the order of restraint against the alienation passed but he is only aggrieved that he has been fettered from altering the character of property. There shall be no alteration of character of property but if there are any repairs necessary, he shall apply to the court, seek its permission and carry it out after showing that the repairs are absolutely necessary and essential for preservation of the property.
3. The order already passed is modified only as regards the latter part referred to above and the revision petition is allowed on the above terms.
