The revision is against the order declining permission to the wife to cross-examine the mother of the husband. There was a complaint also that the wife had not been paid full maintenance. It is now admitted that the maintenance amount has been paid up to November and maintenance is due only for December and January. The counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent says that he will ensure that the amount is paid at the date of trial. Permission declined to the wife to cross-examine the mother of the husband is set aside and the wife shall be entitle to cross-examine and lead her own evidence.

The revision petition is disposed of.
