Learned counsel for the petitioner has pleaded that the petitioner is being deprived of the pension for the last so many years. He contended that the learned Executing Court has framed the issues on the basis of vexatious objection petition moved by the JD's. He contended that even the onus to prove the issues has been wrongly placed as the objection petition was filed by the JD's and burden to prove the objections should have been on the JD's. He further contended that as the petitioner is being deprived of her retiral benefits, the disposal of the objection petition will take longtime, which will cause prejudice to the rights of the petitioner. He pleaded that the Executing Court may be

directed to expedite the disposal of the objection petition. The petitioner will conclude her evidence in just two short adjournments.

In view of the aforesaid, the present revision petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the learned Executing Court to dispose of the objection petition filed by the JD's on the basis of which the issues have been framed on 17.12.2015 within five months from the date of receiving this order by the learned trial Court.
