The present revision petition has been preferred against the interim order dated 16.10.2014 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Gurdaspur, staying the execution proceedings filed by the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the objection petition filed by the respondents was dismissed by the learned executing Court while passing the well reasoned order. There was no reason to stay execution proceedings. He further contended that the appeal is pending before the learned Additional District Judge for the last about

two years and is fixed for 07.04.2016.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner prayed that the learned Additional District Judge may be directed to expeditiously dispose of the appeal as the process of the execution is held up.

4. Learned counsel for respondent No.1 has no objection to this proposal.

5. Thus, the present revision petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to learned Additional District Judge, Gurdaspur/appellate Court to dispose of the appeal within three months from today.
